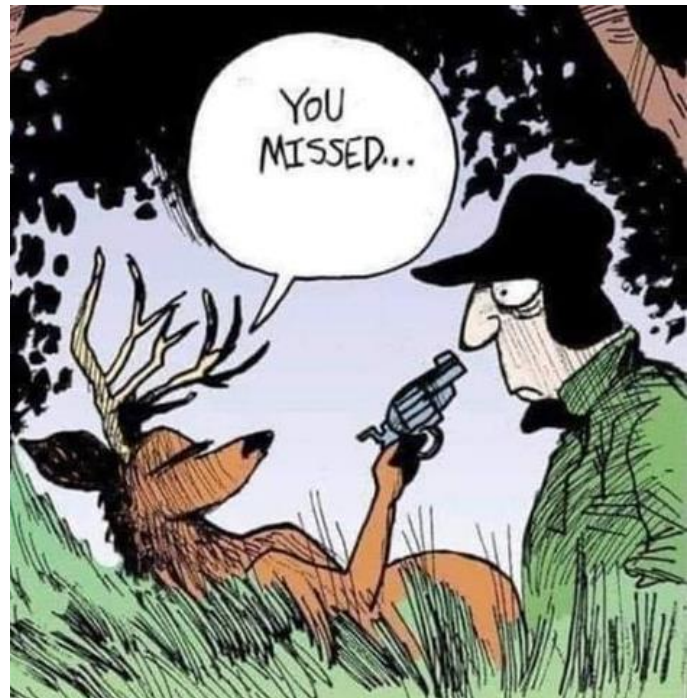

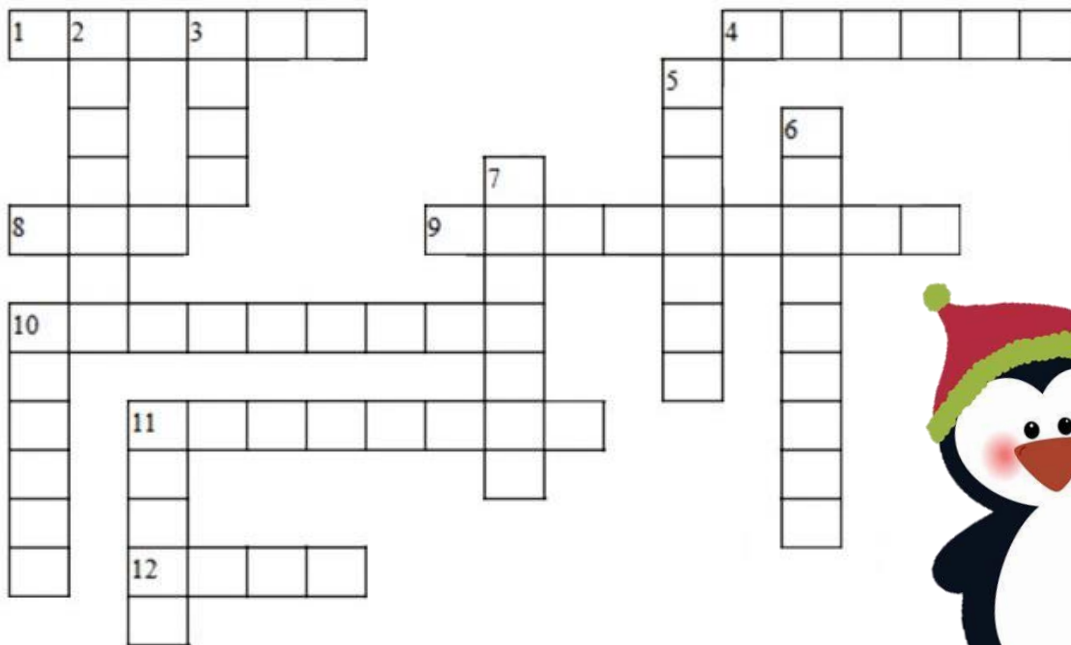


Brain Teasers
