Registration is a one-time fee of \$10. You will receive a metal tag to put onto your pet's collar.

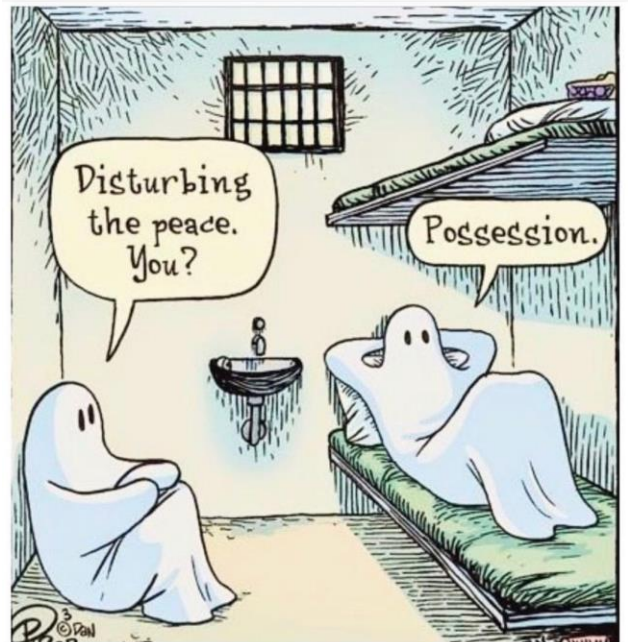
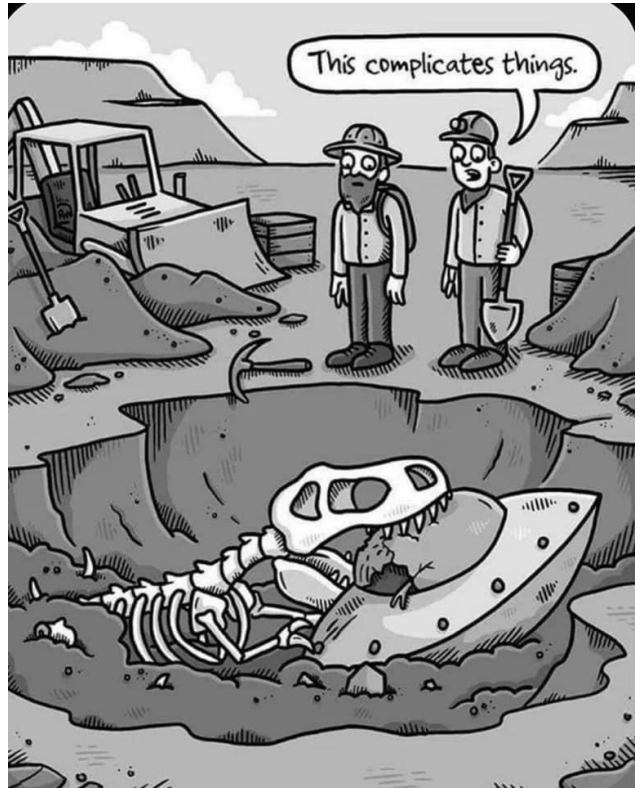
