Since then there has been roughly 320 volunteer hours put towards the truck involving everything from maintenance to applying decals and installing water tanks. This truck is intended to make it easier and more efficient for the Department to respond to calls. The Department is excited to be able to put the truck into service soon!

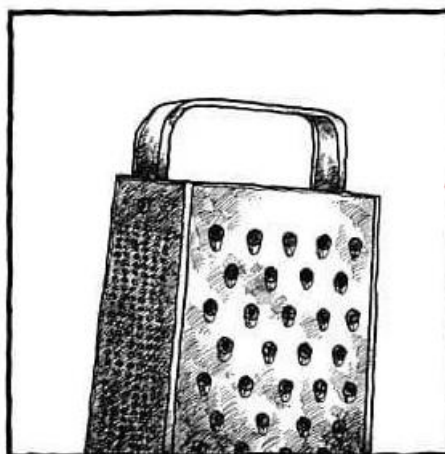
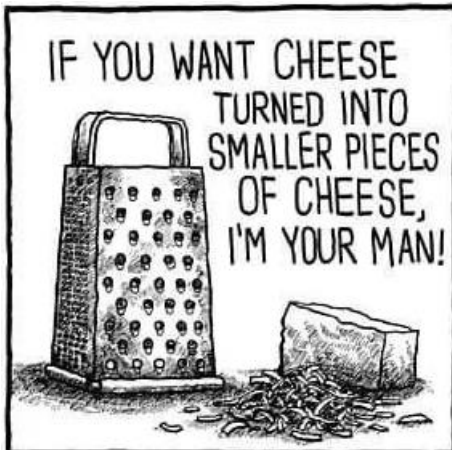
Street Sweeping

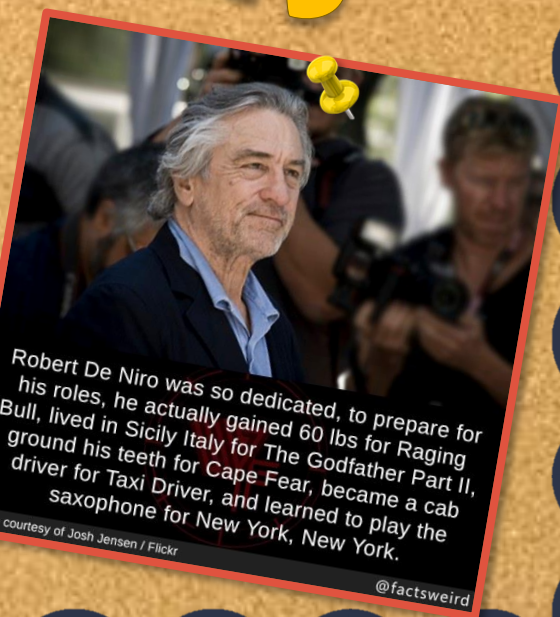
FUN FACTS
