When Energy Code is Required



Dwelling

All newly constructed, insulated dwellings must meet energy code requirements. Whether the dwelling is a primary residence or seasonal occupancy, it must comply with the energy code.



Addition

Additions, alterations, repairs, renovations or relocations of buildings constructed prior to January 1, 2019 do not need to meet the energy code.



Building With Plumbing

If an accessory building contains a washroom or plumbing facilities (e.g. a kitchen), it must meet energy code requirements.



Plumbing Exemptions

If the plumbed room in an accessory building is 10 m² or less, and insulated from the remainder of the building, the rest of the building might be exempt from the energy code (consult your building official).

Water Rate Increase

The Village of Lipton and the Saskatchewan Municipal Board have approved a water rate increase of \$1.00 for 2025. This means that starting January 1, 2025 the amount you are charged for water will increase by \$1.00. Below is a portion of Schedule A from Bylaw 07-2023 Sewer and Water Bylaw.

1. Monthly Water Rates for users within the Village of Lipton limits:

All categories

3,000 gallons or less Minimum \$50.00 for 2025
and \$12.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

2. Monthly Water Rates for users outside the Village of Lipton limits:

3,000 gallons or less Minimum \$72.35 for 2025
and \$12.00 for each additional 1,000 gallons thereafter.

3. Monthly Infrastructure Fee (Water and Sewer upgrades)

Monthly fee: Minimum \$23.00 **NO CHANGE**
